# The Path of Repentance ...

O Lord, open my lips,
and my mouth will declare your praise.

16 You do not delight in sacrifice, or I would bring it;
You do not take pleasure in burnt offerings.

17 The sacrifices of God are a broken spirit;
A broken and contrite heart,
O God, you will not despise. (From Psalm 51)

During Lent, we give special focus to suffering and death of our Lord Jesus Christ. We consider Christ's mission as the Holy Lamb of God who gave his life for our sins and the sins of the whole world. We entered the season of Lent on the last Wednesday of February—Ash Wednesday. The forty days leading up to our Lord's crucifixion is a special time of reflection on repentance from sin.

Repentance is no fun at all. It's not just eating humble pie, or saying, "I was wrong." It means completely unlearning—going a different direction from where we naturally would go. It means a death to self... undergoing a kind of death to self-will and self-conceit.

This willing submission, this dying to self and accepting humiliation is **not** something that God demands before he will take you back. "God demonstrates his own love for us in this: While we were still sinners, Christ died for us." (Romans 5:8)

Repentance rather is a description of what returning to God is really like. If I ask God to take me back without it, it's like going back, but never actually arriving to receive God's loving embrace. Repentance isn't just pious reverence. It's a heart longing for deeper fellowship with the Father, the Son and the Holy Spirit and sincere realization and lament of how our sinful selves get in the way of that.

Take the great story of repentance that Jesus shared in Luke 15:11ff. as your example. The lost son remembered the heart of his loving father, the blessings of his father's household and was willing to take to the lowest position just to serve in his household again. Make this Lent journey one to know the love of Christ intimately and to be transformed by His love. As the lost son did, we come to our senses when we remember where our home really is and whose will is really best for us. Surely there are things in our lives that we should trust God to change. "The sacrifice you desire is a broken spirit. You will not reject a broken and repentant heart, O God." Psalm 51:17 (NLT)

# I Go To Prepare A Place For You

It seems we're always making preparations or getting ready for something. Preparing for a meeting, interview, project, trip, appointment, presentation, visit, and a checkup. Preparation is important. I just need some help in doing the planning a little faster. I find that good planning, makes for better outcomes. A well organized and thought out presentation, benefits everyone. While it may take more time up front, to prepare a good program, the results are worth it. Everyone who participates should gain from the experience, and feel like their time was well spent, and that they learned something valuable. This is especially true if the presentation is for training purposes. Often times with training or teaching, we only have one (1) shot at getting our point across. We are constrained by the agenda, the training period, or the participants' schedules.

Jesus spent the last 3 years of his earthly life in close fellowship with His disciples. They shared their time and conversation constantly. After so much time doing practically everything together, you would expect that these apostles would know and understand everything that Jesus shared with them. We learn over and over again however, that they were just like us. They needed constantly to be reminded of the meaning of Jesus' teachings. They asked Jesus to explain when he meant many times. In the parables he told, he explained their meaning to them as well.

In one well known Bible passage Jesus told them, (See John 14:1-29 ASV) "Let not your heart be troubled: believe in God, believe also in me. In My Father's house are many mansions; if it were not so, I would have told you; for I go to prepare a place for you. And if I go and prepare a place for you, I come again, and will receive you unto myself; that where I am, there ye may be also."

We may struggle to understand how this can be, much like the disciples did, who were right there with Jesus when he told them that he was preparing a place for them. How amazing to know that Jesus is preparing a place for all of us! We should know that His preparations are made with the greatest of care. He does so with the full, complete and total understanding of who each of us is. His preparations are perfect.

I pray that you may hear Christ speaking directly to you, and speaking those words that he is preparing a place for you. Let us spend time in The Word, to know that Christ does speak to us, and that in our hearing, we are most certainly closer to our Savior, Jesus Christ.
